On Carnegie-Mellon University Campus, N side of Frew St., W of Tech St. Brick with granite trim, 91'-8" (five-bay front) x 54'-6" (three bays) with stairhall (46'-2" x 25'-11") on W (rear) elevation, three stories with partially exposed basement, hip roof with cross-gable roof running E-W forming pediment over projecting pavilion

Built 1914, part of original competition-winning campus design by Henry Hornbostel, architect; connected to Porter Hall by later addition by Hornbostel. 14 sheets (1963-65, including site plan, plans, elevations, sections, details); HABS (1965).
