Materials of Construction Long leaf yellow pine from Louisiana.

Additional Data Built by Guy M. Brown, an early Galveston shipper who came to Galveston in the early 50's. The present site of the house was originally in the center of a ten acre tract. Mr. Bartlett Moore bought the place from Colonel Dennison and the home was known as the old Dennison Home.

This house was built during the period of Galveston's greatest prosperity. Extremely difficult to photograph on account of the almost tropical foliage around it. Good Greek Revival marred by the introduction of screens between the columns. The wood fan light above the front door is especially good as also is the second floor porch(gallery) balustrade.

There are no known available records or history other than that shown above. This information is from Mr. Bartlett Moore.
