Limestone, irregular ashlar, with board and batten, single-bay gable-end facade, shallow gabled roof, outer stairs to second-floor entrance door at gable end; shed-roofed board and batten lean-to at rear, with entrance door on side, near bottom of stairs. Said to be the first structure built by Dietrick Rode in a complex of buildings including another barn, a blacksmith shop, smokehouse, a large
