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
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
## PREFACE

There are six separate and distinct routes to Milwaukee and by slight variations and combinations many more are possible. In selecting this route it was necessary to try all the direct roads under both favorable and unfavorable weather conditions, entailing a great deal of work and considerable fuel and patience.

The selection herein made is the best possible route. The "Shore," "Green Bay," "Howell," "New," "Loomis," and "New Chicago" are all good in places under favorable weather conditions. The one selected is not a macadamized boulevard, by any means; it has its good and bad spots the same as all the others, though the bad ones are not as numerous as in following any single one of the above-named routes. After heavy rains the one given recovers more quickly than the others. Also one of the principal reasons for selecting the entire route as photographed was that the people and horses are more familiar with automobiles, reducing that source of danger and delay, and as a rule, favors are readily granted.

The entrance to Milwaukee is made through a residence part of the city. The entire selection of the route has been made with the following views in mind: Pleasure, good roads, shortness and as few railroad crossings as possible.

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
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## PREFACE

The compilation of this book was undertaken at the urgent requests of many who have made the trip and know what a truly delightful one it is; also requests were received from summer residents owning cottages bordering on many of the pretty lakes that can be reached by following the directions given.

The trip to Lake Geneva and Beloit is truly delightful. If a shorter trip is desired, one from Chicago to Fox Lake, Pistakee Lake, Loon Lake (Antioch), Lake Villa, Bangs Lake (Wauconda), or McHenry on the Fox River, will be found a very enjoyable one, that can be made in one day, up and back.

There are various ways of reaching Lake Geneva, but none better than the route given. The others were tried, but the routes selected are the best, all weather conditions considered.

The roads given are principally gravel, but well worked and high enough for proper drainage. The time required to make the run from Chicago to Lake Geneva, including reasonable stops, is six hours. The entire route passes through a rich dairy farming country, well wooded and slightly rolling. There are no really bad hills and few railroad crossings. The towns are old and some not even on a railroad line. The route lies in four counties; after leaving Cook, you pass into Lake and McHenry counties to Walworth County, Wis.

Lake Geneva and Delavan Lake are in Walworth County, Wis.; Beloit in Rock County, on the border line of Winnebago County, Ill.

## ROUTE INSTRUCTIONS

### CHICAGO TO LAKE GENEVA

Upon leaving the Stratford Hotel, Jackson Blvd. and Michigan Ave., travel north upon Michigan Ave. to Rush St. bridge, crossing to Ohio St. (Photo 2), turn east one block to Lincoln Park Blvd. (Photo 3), then north to Lincoln Park, passing through the park to extreme northwest corner (Diversey Blvd. and Lake Shore Drive), (Photo 4); follow Drive north to end, where Sheridan Drive commences (Photo 5); turn west to police box (Photo 6), then north to Devon St., then west to street car tracks, then north (Photo 7) to Pratt Ave., yellow police box on corner (Photo 8); west upon Pratt Ave. to Ridge Ave.; south upon Ridge Ave., passing through Evanston; beyond Evanston Golf Club turn to left and then to right (Photo 10); two blocks beyond this turn (Photo 11) turn to left, upon Lake Ave., Wilmette; follow this road to its end (Photo 12), then turn to right one-half mile, then to left (Photo 13), west to Libertyville Road, upon which to right and north (Photo 14) at Half Day bridge (Photo 15). Do not cross, but turn to left upon road that branches southwest; this road leads direct to Lake Zurich (Photo 17), where turn is made to right, passing upon road skirting north banks of lake to (Photo 18) where right turn and north is made. After making turn keep straight ahead until you come to creamery, also store on opposite corner (Photo 19), then left. Arriving at Wauconda and Bangs Lake, keep straight through town and to right, at Photo 20 to left, when you come to end of road (Photo 21); turn to left and continue west to Fox River bridge, crossing to McHenry (Photo 22); keep straight ahead; at church (Photo 23) turn to right; keep to right at fork (Photo 24); at second fork (Photo 25) to right (the left road looks the most inviting; be sure and take the right). Arriving at end of road (Photo 26), to left. When you come to Richmond keep straight ahead through town, beyond which, when arriving at little white church on right, turn to left (Photo 28). Arriving at cross road (Photo 29), to left. Your next turn is upon the main street of Genoa, at hotel corner (Photo 30), to right; crossing bridge over swamp turn to right (Photo 31). When you come to road's end (Photo 32), to left and follow telegraph poles as an assuring guide to (Photo 33), where turn to left is made. When you arrive at top of hill (Photo 34), use care in descending, for at times rains have been known to cause bad holes in road's surface. Beyond hill fork is encountered (Photo 35); keep to right; road from here to Lake Geneva is direct. When you arrive at point where road one block ahead descends (Photo 36), turn to left and go two blocks to lake (Photo 37); turn to right and keep ahead to Hotel Denison (Photo 38). For Williams Bay, Delavan Lake, Delavan and Beloit see other instructions.

## ROUTE INSTRUCTIONS

### FROM LAKE GENEVA TO WILLIAMS BAY, DELAVAN LAKE, DELAVAN AND BELOIT

Upon leaving main corner of Lake Geneva (Photo 1), go west to (Photo 2) red shed setting flush with road upon left (Photo 2); turn south one mile and one-half for Williams Bay. For Delavan, keep ahead until barns and windmill are encountered (Photo 3), then to right, arriving at hill turn to left (Photo 4). At first road south after you have passed light colored barns on left, turn to left (Photo 5) for Lake Delavan resorts. For the town of Delavan keep ahead until you come to end of macadam (Photo 6), then to right until you come to brick church on right (Photo 7), then to left on the main street in Delavan.

For Beloit, go west upon the main streets of Delavan to creamery on right (Photo 8), then to left, crossing bridge. When you arrive at top of hill take road to left (Photo 9). From here the road is direct to Beloit.

### RETURN FROM LAKE GENEVA

From Hotel Denison south to bridge (Photo 2), east to main road (Photo 4), southeast to white schoolhouse (Photo 5); there take left fork to top of hill (Photo 6); follow telegraph poles and most traveled road to bridge (Photo 7), crossing. Genoa can be seen in distance. Entering upon main street of Genoa, turn to left at hotel corner (Photo 8); follow road to sharp turn (Photo 9), to right. At Richmond, just before you come to bridge, turn to left (Photo 10); the road is straight to Channel Lake. Arriving at white school on left (Photo 11) turn to right. Road is direct to Antioch, where you turn to right and south (Photo 12); at store building beyond Loon Lake keep to right (Photo 13); at milk shed keep to left (Photo 14); at fork in road (Photo 15) to right. At Gray's Lake keep straight ahead until you come to red brick school on left; turn to left (Photo 16), passing south of school and east. This road is direct to Libertyville road. There turn south (Photo 17). From there road leads to Half Day direct (Photo 18). There turn to left and follow road straight to C. & N. W. Ry. tracks (Photo 19). There turn to right, at viaduct (Photo 20) to left. Arriving at brick school on left, turn to right. Arriving at Central Avenue, Highland Park (Photo 22), Sheridan Drive is encountered, which can be followed direct to Chicago.
