





 Nathaniell Borne the 29<sup>th</sup> of the 10<sup>th</sup> month 1652 in pauls-yard London.  
 Deceased the 12<sup>th</sup> of y<sup>e</sup> 10<sup>th</sup> M. 1653. Buried in pankridg ould Mashowse  
 in Soper Lane, London.  
 Nathaniell 2<sup>d</sup> Borne the 2<sup>d</sup> day of the eighth month 1654 in Paulsyard London.  
 Joseph Borne 24<sup>th</sup> of the 4<sup>th</sup> month 1656 in paulsyard London.  
 Benjamin Borne the 22<sup>d</sup> of the 4<sup>th</sup> month 1657. Deceased the 10<sup>th</sup> month 1657,  
 buried at Hatfield Broadoak in Essex in the grave yard.  
 Hannah Sikes Borne the 2<sup>d</sup> day of the eighth month 1658 in paulsyard London.  
 Sarah Sikes borne the 9<sup>th</sup> day of the 3<sup>d</sup> month 1660 att Hamerton Hackney p'ish.  
 Rebeca Sikes borne in the Castle in Bristol the 7<sup>th</sup> day of the first month being  
 the 7<sup>th</sup> day of the week about the 3<sup>d</sup> or 4<sup>th</sup> howr in the morneing 1662.  
 Dorcas Sikes borne in frenchay in the p'ish of Winterborne the 11<sup>th</sup> of the 4<sup>th</sup> M.  
 1667 about 1 or 2 in the afternoon being the 3<sup>d</sup> day of y<sup>e</sup> weeke.

Thomas and Mary Smith were married at London Wall November the 30 ann. Dom.  
1682.

Thomas Smith was Borne August the 25<sup>th</sup> 1683 being Saterdag about two a clock  
in the After noone In Lenord fosters Parish.

Mary Smith was borne September the Sixth 1684 at five a clock in the morning  
being Saterdag In Cock Court in S<sup>t</sup> Martins.

Elizabeth Smith was borne the first of february in Cock Court In S<sup>t</sup> Martins Le-  
grand London in the parish of Leonord fosters An<sup>o</sup> Dom. 1684.

John Sikes & Mary (*d. of John*) Ashe were married at Westham in Essex by Joshua  
Stanley Vicar y<sup>e</sup> 27<sup>th</sup> day of September being Tuesday 1687.

John Sikes, my first child, was borne at y<sup>e</sup> blind beggar's house at Bethnall Green in Midd<sup>x</sup>sex fryday y<sup>e</sup> 5<sup>th</sup> of October about 6 oth' clock in y<sup>e</sup> morning 1688 & baptized in y<sup>e</sup> same house thursday 25<sup>th</sup> same month in y<sup>e</sup> afternoon by Thos. Cole in presence of Moth<sup>r</sup> Ashe Uncle & Aunt Walton B<sup>r</sup> & S<sup>r</sup> Ashe B<sup>r</sup> & S<sup>r</sup> Standcliffe\* B<sup>r</sup> Jn<sup>o</sup> Ashe S<sup>r</sup> Dale S<sup>r</sup> Hannah &c.

Memorand<sup>m</sup> my son John went to School & board with B<sup>r</sup> Haynes at Bednall Green y<sup>e</sup> 9<sup>th</sup> day of September 1695 at p' an'um

Gobert Sikes my 2<sup>d</sup> was born at my house in Well Street in Hackney Parish the thirtieth of November 1689 being Saterdag about 2 oth' clock afternoon & baptized there by M<sup>r</sup>. Thomas Cole on fryday 13<sup>th</sup> of December same year before dinner.

Thomas my third child was borne at my house in Well Street Hackney Tuesday y<sup>e</sup> 5<sup>th</sup> of April 1692 at twelve o'clock at noon & baptized there by M<sup>r</sup> Thomas Cole on fryday 22<sup>d</sup> same month before noon.

Elizabeth my fourth child was born at my house in Well Street Hackney Saterdag o'clock in y<sup>e</sup> morning being y<sup>e</sup> 24<sup>th</sup> of february 1692 & there baptized by M<sup>r</sup> Thomas Cole on fryday 28<sup>d</sup> March following at 8 oth' clock afternoone.

Mary my 5<sup>th</sup> child was borne at my new house in Well Street Hackney on y<sup>e</sup> Lord's day half an' houre after 11 at night being y<sup>e</sup> 22<sup>th</sup> of June 1701 & baptiz'd in same house by M<sup>r</sup> Rob<sup>t</sup> Billis on Wensday 2<sup>d</sup> of July following in y<sup>e</sup> forenoon.

Gobert Sikes & Ann Hill were marryed at S<sup>t</sup> Thomas Hospitall in Southwark by M<sup>r</sup> Mayo 12 7ber being Saterdag 1719.

Ann Sikes my First Child was borne in the Parish of S<sup>t</sup> Michael Basishaw Tuesday y<sup>e</sup> 14<sup>th</sup> June 1720 about one of the clock in y<sup>e</sup> morn<sup>s</sup> & baptized 1 July by the Rev<sup>d</sup> D<sup>r</sup> Roderick. Coz. J<sup>no</sup> Holden Godfather Sister Hill & Mrs Dalton Godmothers.

John Sikes my Second child born at my house in Savage gardens Cutchid Fryers Saterdag 16 June 1722. Xtened by M<sup>r</sup> Arrowsmith 22 June Brother Thos. Sikes & M<sup>r</sup> John Thompson† Godfathers Aunt Hill Godm<sup>r</sup>.

Thomas Sikes & Jane Robinson was marryed at Eastham Church in Essex 29<sup>th</sup> Sep<sup>r</sup> 1726 by M<sup>r</sup> Carter Vicker of Lowlayton.

My first child Eliz<sup>a</sup> Sikes was Borne at my house in Marke lane Sunday night y<sup>e</sup> 6 day August 1727: and chrisned by M<sup>r</sup> Parker Curat to D<sup>r</sup> Arrowsmith of y<sup>e</sup> Church in Crutched fryers. Cap. Franc<sup>s</sup> Robinson Godfather Eliz<sup>a</sup> Robinson & Sister Eliz<sup>a</sup> Sikes Godmothers.

My 2<sup>d</sup> child Tho<sup>s</sup> Sikes was Borne in Marke lane at my house before mentioned Sunday morning 24 Feb. 1732 and Xn<sup>d</sup> by D<sup>r</sup> Arrowsmith Godfathers Papillon Ball & Denham Hamond† Godm<sup>r</sup> Sister Mary Sikes.

My 3<sup>d</sup> child Jane Sikes was Borne in Water Gruel row in Hackney Monday night first March 1742 and chris<sup>t</sup> by D<sup>r</sup> Wright Vicker of Hackney Godfather Papillon Ball Godmothers Sis<sup>r</sup> Eliz<sup>a</sup> Ball & daughter Eliz<sup>a</sup> Sikes.

Elizabeth Sikes daughter of the aforesaid Thomas and Jane was married to Henry Sawbridge§ 9 October 1752 at the parish Church of S<sup>t</sup> Steph<sup>n</sup> albrook by the Rev. M<sup>r</sup> Jn<sup>o</sup> Lewis.

of Thomas and Jane Sikes, died on the 7<sup>th</sup> of October, 1857, aged 90 years.  
Henry Sikes, Esquire, died 12<sup>th</sup> of November, 1864, aged 91. The last survivor of  
the above family.
