6TH ARMY GROUP. (261200B). FIRST FRENCH ARMY. (Army Troops). GROUPMENT de CLERCK and 1st French Armored Division (with 9th RCA atchd). No change.

I French Corps. 5th French Armored Division. (With 8th and 11th RCAs atchd). The 1st RSA assigned to replace the Division Reconnaissance Squadron which had been previously assigned to the 19th French Region. 4th French Mountain Division. (With 126th Inf and 19th BCP atchd). The 2d Group Moroccan Tabors relieved from attachment to the 4th French Mountain Division and attached to the 2d Moroccan Division in the vicinity of LINDENBG. C6291. The 19th BCP attached to the 4th French Mountain Division in the vicinity of ST ANTON V1844. 2d Moroccan Division. The 2d Group Moroccan Tabors attached on 26 May.

II French Corps. 1st and 4th Groups Moroccan Tabors. Attached to II French Corps.

21 ARMY GROUP. (261200B). I British Corps. Headquarters redesignated Headquarters I Corps District. 49th British Division. (With 1st Cdn Armd Bde atchd). Units of the 56th Brigade concentrated in the area W2500 - W1600 - W1802. The 147th Brigade commenced movement to the vicinity of OSNABRUCK W2108.

SECOND BRITISH ARMY. (Army Troops). 8th US Division, 6th British Airborne Division and 82d US Airborne Division. All no change.

VIII British Corps. 15th Division. (With 106th AA Bde atchd). Division artillery units concentrated in the area S8776 - S9053 - T0172 and in the vicinity of S6542.

XII and XXX British Corps. No change.

FIRST CANADIAN ARMY. (Army Troops). 5th Canadian Armored Division (with 18th Cdn Armd Car Regt atchd), 1st Canadian Infantry Brigade Group and 2d Canadian Armored Brigade. All no change.

II Canadian Corps. 2d Canadian Division. (With 301st Br Inf Bde atchd). 4th Canadian Infantry Brigade concentrated in the area Q9330 - R0439 - Q8837 - Q8342. 4th Canadian Armored Division. Commenced movement to an assembly area in the vicinity of ALMBLO V2718.

4. WEATHER (Germany).

Precipitation: Light, intermittent rain and showers. Clouds: Broken to overcast. Visibility: 3 - 5 miles at dawn, becoming more than 6 miles during the afternoon, except in rain and showers where limited to 2 miles. Wind: Light and variable. Temperatures at WIESBADEN: Maximum 54° F. Minimum 43° F.

THIRD ARMY. XV and XX Corps. No change.

XII Corps. The 115th Anti-Aircraft Artillery Group occupied and assumed responsibility for LANDKREIS MALLERSDORF U3530 and LANDKREIS DINGOLFING U5015. 4th Armored Division. Commenced movement to a new sector in the vicinity of LANDSHUT U2503 - NEUMARKT T7182. 5th Division. Occupied and assumed responsibility for LANDKREIS GRIESBACH V0595.

V and III Corps. No change.

NINTH ARMY. (Army Troops). 2d Armored Division and 29th Division. No change.

VIII Corps. 89th Division. The 354th Infantry commenced movement to an assembly area in the vicinity of DEAUVILLE, FRANCE I4513 at 270700B.

XIII Corps. 30th Division. Units of the 52d British Division relieved units of the 30th Division in LANDKREIS WOLMIRSTEET Y6510, LANDKREIS CALBE D7577 and LANDKREIS WANZLEBEN D5587 and assumed responsibility for the area. The 117th Infantry commenced movement to VIII Corps zone. 102d Division. Units of the 52d British Division relieved the 406th Infantry in LANDKREIS SALZWEDEL Y3065 and assumed responsibility for the area. Units of the 102d Division commenced movement to VIII Corps zone.

XVI Corps. 35th Division. Motor elements of the 134th Infantry commenced movement to an assembly area in the vicinity of KOBLENZ L9094.
