BOUNDARY CHANGE:

Boundary change between 12th Army Group and 21 Army Group (effective 111200B):  
As before to vicinity D2748 - thence west along south boundary of LANDEKREIS  
BLANKENBURG D2055 and south boundary of PROVINZ HANNOVER to vicinity C1840 -  
thence as before.

3. ADJACENT UNITS AND SUPPORTING TROOPS.

6TH ARMY GROUP. (101200B). FIRST FRENCH ARMY. (Army Troops). GROUPEMENT de  
CLERCK, 1st French Armored Division (with 9th Regt de Chasseurs Algeriens atchd)  
and 10th French Division. All no change.

II French Corps. No change.

I French Corps. 5th French Armored Division. Armored infantry units commenced  
movement to the vicinity of STRASSBURG W0198.

21 ARMY GROUP. (101200B). I British Corps District. 53 British Division.  
Units of the division closed in the general area A1009, F4884 and F2176 and com-  
menced relief of units of XXII US Corps in REGIERUNGS BEZIRK DUSSELDORF. The 78  
and 158 Brigades commenced movement to I British Corps District.

XXX British Corps District. Units completed the relief of the 84th US  
Division and assumed responsibility for the area. 5 British Division. The 15  
Infantry Brigade assumed responsibility for the 155 Brigade (52 Div) area as of  
091800B. The 13 Brigade Group commenced movement to XXX Corps area.

SECOND BRITISH ARMY. (Army Troops). 82 US Airborne Division. No change.

VIII British Corps. 15 British Division (with 17 Bde atchd). 46 Brigade com-  
menced movement to vicinity of BAD KLEINEN T4681 and WISMAR T4594. The 17 Brigade  
commenced movement to XXX British Corps District.

XII British Corps. No change.

FIRST CANADIAN ARMY. (Army Troops). 5 Canadian Armored Division (with 18th  
Armd Car Regt atchd), 1st Canadian Infantry Brigade Group, 2d Canadian Armored  
Brigade and 4th Canadian Armored Division. All no change.

II and I Canadian Corps. No change.

AIR. (10 June). No operations.

4. WEATHER (Germany).

Precipitation: Light occasional rain. Clouds: Broken to overcast. Visibility:  
3 - 5 miles becoming 4 - 8 miles after 1000B but remaining low in rain. Wind: West  
10 miles per hour. Temperatures at WIESBADEN: Maximum 72° F. Minimum 57° F.

relieve the 44th Division of responsibility for LANDKREIS BUCHEN N2000. 84th Division. Units continued movement to the vicinity of MANNHEIM R5398. The division assumed responsibility for LANDKREIS BERGSTRASSE M7020, LANDKREIS MANNHEIM R6095, LANDKREIS HEIDELBERG R8085, LANDKREIS MOESBACH S0590, LANDKREIS ERBACH M9020 and those portions of LANDKREIS WORMS M4520, LANDKREIS DARMSTADT M6535, LANDKREIS DIEBURG M8540, LANDKREIS SINSHEIM R8570, LANDKREIS GROSS-GERAU M5545 in Seventh Army zone.

THIRD ARMY. (Army Troops). 97th Division. No change.

XV Corps. 11th Armored Division. Continued to relieve the 80th Division (XX Corps). 42d Division. Continued to relieve the 103d Division in LANDKREIS SCHWABZ EO570.

XX Corps. 71st Division. Commenced movement to the northern portion of REGIERUNGS BEZIRK SCHWABEN. 80th Division. Commenced movement to the southern portion of REGIERUNGS BEZIRK SCHWABEN.

XII Corps. 83d Division. Closed in the 5th Division sector in the vicinity of VILSHOFEN Q0119.

V Corps. 79th Division. Continued to close in the vicinity of EGER P3174 and assumed responsibility for the 1st Division sector.

III Corps. 1st Division. Continued to close in the vicinity of ANSBACH T0682 and assumed responsibility for the 4th Division sector. 4th Division. Continued to close in the vicinity of BAMBERG O2749. 11th Cavalry Group. Closed in the vicinity of ERLANGEN O3616.

NINTH ARMY. (Army Troops). 2d Armored, 29th, 75th and 95th Divisions. All no change.

XXI and VIII Corps. No change.

VII Corps. 7th Armored Division. Assumed complete responsibility for the 104th Division sector in the vicinity of HALLE D9428. 104th Division. Commenced movement to an assembly area in the vicinity of LE HAVRE L5027.

XIII Corps. Relieved of responsibility for former area 111200B.

XIX and XVI Corps. No change.

FIFTEENTH ARMY. XXIII Corps. No change.

XXII Corps. 61st Field Artillery Brigade. Continued to be relieved by units of the 53d British Division (I Br Corps District) in that portion of REGIERUNGS BEZIRK DUSSELDORF west of the RHINE River. 17th Airborne Division. Continued to be relieved by units of the 53d British Division (I Br Corps District) in that portion of REGIERUNGS BEZIRK DUSSELDORF east of the RHINE River. 94th Division. Units were relieved by the 160th Brigade (53d Pr Div) of responsibility for LANDKREIS DUSSELDORF F3592.
