6TH ARMY GROUP. (291200B). FIRST FRENCH ARMY. (Army Troops). GROUPMENT de CLERCK, 1st French Armored Division (with 9th Regt de Chasseurs Algeriens atchd) and 10th French Division. All no change.

II and I French Corps. No change.

21 ARMY GROUP. (291200B). I British Corps District, XXX British Corps District and VIII British Corps District. All no change.

SECOND BRITISH ARMY HEADQUARTERS. No change.

FIRST CANADIAN ARMY. (Army Troops). 4th Canadian Armored Division, 5th Canadian Armored Division (with 18th Cdn Armd Car Regt atchd) and 2d Canadian Armored Brigade. All no change.

I Canadian Corps. No change.

AIR. (29 June). No operations.

4. WEATHER (Germany):

Precipitation: Scattered showers. Clouds: Broken to overcast, decreasing after sunset. Visibility: 2 - 4 miles at dawn becoming more than 6 miles by 1000B, except in showers where limited to 2 miles. Wind: Light and variable. Temperatures at WIESEBADEN: Maximum 76° F. Minimum 52° F.

5. OUR OPERATIONS.

12TH ARMY GROUP. (Army Group Troops). Ninth Army Headquarters, Headquarters Company and Special Troops. No change.

SEVENTH ARMY. (Army Troops). 2d Armored Division and 29th Division. No change.

VI Corps. 1st Armored Division. Assigned to 12th Army Group and Seventh Army and attached to VI Corps on 29 June. Closed in LANDKREIS HALL S5060 and LANDKREIS CRAILSHEIM S6570 at 292000B.

XIX and VIII Corps. No change.

XXI Corps. 30th Division. Relieved by units of 76th and 102d Divisions. 76th Division. Relieved the 30th Division in LANDKREISE AUERBACH K3020, CELSMITZ K1505, PIAUFEN K1020, ZIEGENRUCK J7530, SCHLEIZ J8520 and the eastern portion of LANDKREIS SAALFELD J5535 and assumed responsibility for the area at 282350B. 102d Division. Relieved units of the 30th Division in the western portion of LANDKREIS SAALFELD J5535 and assumed responsibility for the area at 282350B.

THIRD ARMY. II Corps. No change.

XX Corps. 44th Anti-Aircraft Artillery Brigade. Continued to relieve the 20th Armored Division in LANDKREIS TRAUENSTEIN Z6030 and the 101st Airborne Division in LANDKREIS BERCHTESGADEN Z9010. 115th Cavalry Group. The 104th and 107th Cavalry Reconnaissance Squadrons cleared the Army Group area enroute to an assembly
