1. FRONT LINE: Not applicable.

BOUNDARY CHANGE:

First Canadian Army rear boundary changed as follows (effective 010001B July):  
From present boundary vicinity of E5460 - thence north to E5473 - west along DE LEK  
River to bridge in the vicinity of E1781 - north along road to road and canal  
junction in the vicinity of E1790 - west along canal to railroad and canal junction  
in the vicinity of E0392 - northeast along railroad to MERWEDE Canal in vicinity  
of E1299 - north along MERWEDE Canal to junction with railroad in the vicinity of  
Z1415 - northwest along WESPER Canal to junction with railroad under construction  
in the vicinity of Z1118 - west and north along railroad under construction to the  
vicinity of Z0227 - north along railroad to bridge in the vicinity of Z0228 - east  
to canal in the vicinity of Z0328 - Z0429 - Z0628 - Z0826 - Z0925 - Z1025 - thence  
southeast along road to the sea in the vicinity of Z1124.

eved by Soviet Forces in western portion of PROVINZ MAGDEBURG and commenced to  
close in the southern portion of REGIERUNGSBEZIRKE HILDESHEIM in the vicinity of  
GOSLAR C8572, EINBECK C4760, GOTTINGEN C5328 area.

VIII British Corps District. 15th British Division. Assumed responsibility  
for LANDKREIS SEGENERG S5090 and LANDKREIS PINNEBERG S3570. 7th British Armored  
Division. Assumed responsibility for LANDKREIS STEINBURG S1590.

dian Armored Division (with 18th Cdn Armd Car Regt atchd) and 2d Canadian Armored

Closed in an assembly area in LANDKREIS ROTENBERG H4570 at 021420B. Attached to XIX Corps. 76th Division. Commenced to close in an assembly area in the vicinity of HOF 09798. 102d Division. Continued movement to an assembly area in the vicinity of VILSHOFEN Q0119. 4th Cavalry Group. Continued movement to the XIX Corps area. 6th Cavalry Group. Continued movement to assembly area in the vicinity of COBURG 02989.

VIII Corps. Headquarters and Headquarters Company and VIII Corps Artillery. Closed in an assembly area in the vicinity of DILLENBURG G3937 at 021910B.

XX Corps. 44th Anti-Aircraft Artillery Brigade. Continued to relieve the 101st Airborne Division in LANDKREIS BERCHTESGADEN Z9010. 9th Division.
