Correspondents include R. D. Carmichael, James McKeen Cattell, Clarence Day, John Dewey, Waldo David Frank, Dorothy Canfield Fisher, David Starr Jordan, Theodore W. Richards, William Emerson Ritter, Upton Sinclair, and Frederick Winslow Taylor. Topics covered include economics, ethics, logic, mathematics, philosophy, psychology, religion, and science.
