
HAVE HOME-MADE BREAD WITH LITTLE LABOR—Home-made bread has grown to be a luxury largely because it is hard to make, and not one housewife in a hundred has the skill and lightness of hand necessary to knead light, firm bread. But the Saffire Bread Mixer-Kneader, made by Manning, Bowman & Co., Meriden, Conn., will make bread equal to the most delicious of the loaves of our childhood days. It saves the toil and does away with the need for special skill. It mixes and kneads from one to eight loaves in five minutes. The deep, wide pall is clamped to the table. The specially designed blades run down the inside and across the bottom of the pall, remaining stationary while the pall itself is revolved by the crank handle at the side. The movement of the dough is astonishingly like that of hand kneading. The ingredients are thoroughly mixed and the dough moulded into a ball. The only handling needed is in shaping the loaf. Price, \$2.25.



AN ELECTRIC WASHING MACHINE WITH MOVING PARTS—The Copper Electric Washing Machine is made by the Hurley Machine Co., New York and Chicago. It is a "dolly" type—that is, an agitator centrally placed in the tub revolves, moving the clothes so that a rubbing action is produced by the corrugated sides and bottom at the same time the soapy water is forced through them, washing them thoroughly. The machine has a corrugated tub, lined inside, and the motor and driving mechanism beneath. The reversible wringer with safety guard is mounted on the upper edge of the tub, and the chain driving it is covered for protection to the operator. This washer has good capacity, works efficiently, and the washing and wringing can be done together or separately. The controlling levers are simple and conveniently placed, and it is provided with flexible connection cord and attachment for operating from a lamp socket. Price \$70.00.



A SQUARE DISHPAN THAT FITS THE SINK—Every woman who washes dishes knows what a nuisance it is to put a round metal dishpan into a square porcelain sink—also what happens to the sink. The Amelco Sink Protecting Dish Pan is made by Amelco & Co., 31 South Frederick Street, Baltimore, Md. It is oblong and made to fit into the sink. It has rubber legs which protect the porcelain surface from scratches and discoloration, but best of all it has a strainer drawer beneath the outlet, which catches all refuse in the dish water and prevents it from passing out through the sink and down the drain. This strainer is easily removed for emptying. The dish pan is durably constructed and much more serviceable than the ordinary round tin style. Price, \$1.50.



AN EFFICIENT AND DURABLY CONSTRUCTED FIRELESS COOKER—The Caloric Fireless Cook Stove, made by the Caloric Co., Juncosville, Wis., has the compartments lined with seamless aluminum and the covers equipped with an automatic safety valve which permits excessive steam to escape while retaining all necessary heat. This device thereby prevents an explosion or serious injury from rising steam upon raising the cover. It is completely insulated, and boiling water placed in the cooker remained after eight hours at a temperature of 135° Fahrenheit. Boiling, roasting, baking and steaming may all be done economically with this fireless cook stove. It is made in various sizes and capacities, the price ranging from \$14.00 to \$43.25. No. 57, complete with equipment as illustrated, is \$36.25. The cookers are made of steel legs. Of course, the steel frame brings it to a most convenient working height and saves stooping.



TWO USEFUL KITCHEN DEVICES—Half a teaspoonful of anything is the most difficult of all amounts to measure accurately. Therefore a Half-Spoon is made by the De Boulville Co., Box 255, Fitchburg, Mass., to make possible an accurate measure of this elusive quantity. The Half-Spoon is equally desirable in the kitchen and the sickroom. Perhaps its greatest value lies in the latter place, for a dish may be spoiled by carelessly measured condiments, but a life may be sacrificed by inaccuracy in measuring medicine. Price, according to material used in construction, 25 cents to \$2.50. It is difficult to core an apple without wasting a good portion of the quarter or half, if the case may be. The Little Gem Apple Corer, made by F. E. Cross, Showhagen, Ind., neatly scoops out the core, leaving the rest of the apple undisturbed. Price, 10 cents. REMOVES BOTH STAINS AND EMBEDDED DIRT FROM CARPETS AND RUGS—The Superior Vacuum Sweeper, made by the Russell Carpet Sweeper Co., New York and Grand Rapids, Mich., is a type that combines carpet sweeping and suction cleaning. It is strongly constructed of first class materials and cleans efficiently when run back and forth over a carpet sweeper machine weighs fourteen pounds and will go under furniture nine and one-half inches high. The marring of furniture and woodwork when accidentally knocked is prevented by the rubber corner cushions and tread with which the front part is equipped. The sweeper at each stroke cleans a strip nine and one-half inches wide, and the dust receptacle is so designed and constructed that it can be removed without spilling the contents and soiling the hands. The roller bristle brush, with its metal dust pan, is similar to a carpet sweeper, and picks up threads, lint, etc., while the suction removes the embedded dirt without raising a dust. A HANDY PLATE SCRAPER—A RAPID INEXPENSIVE TOASTER—The "Kitchen Kumfort" Plate Scraper and the "Androok" Bread Toaster are both made by the Andrews Wire and Iron Works, Rockford, Ill., and New York. The plate scraper is convenient for scraping dishes before placing them in the dishpan. It is less wearing and more efficient than the fork or knife usually used. Also since the working edge is a specially prepared composition of rubber, it will not scratch china nor be affected by the grease or water. Price, 12 cents. The toaster consists of a copper wire mesh mounted upon a 9-inch square sheet of iron perforated with ninety-six funnel openings. When placed over the gas burner the heat rises through these openings and is evenly distributed over the slices of bread, giving them a uniform brown surface. It toasts quickly, and therefore must be watched closely to prevent burning. Price, 10 cents.
