


Left—Four doors give ready access to the pleasing interior of this two-power ranger, Peerless Eight.



Above—A certain smoothness and svelteness (is there such a word?) of outline lend added charm to this Chalmers Sedan.




Above—Taking a liberty—since it's a Liberty Six—has given the lady at the wheel one of those famous "smiles that make you happy."


