DEPOT, Delaware, Jan. 1801.

I do myself the pleasure to send you a
short sketch of the principles upon which
the law for opening a communication be-

tween the waters of the Chesapeake and
Delaware passed the Legislature of this
State, yesterday.

Generally this law is like the one pass-
ed by the Legislature of Maryland. The
principal exceptions are these: First when-

ever, and for longer a term, than is con-

tained in the tolls, shall amount to ten
per centum, per annum, or more, the com-
pany are to pay into the treasury of this
State, one-tenth part of the net profits, an-

nually, in half yearly payments, for ever.
Secondly, The rate of tolls fixed by the
acts are not to be lessened without the as-

sent of the Legislature of this State.
Thirdly, The law is to be of no force or
effect until the State of Pennsylvania pass-

es a law to authorize an agent to be ap-
pointed on the part of this State to con-

clude such title papers as relate to any land
within this government, which cannot be
removed, removed the records of the office
of the office in which the same may be, and
such papers, thereof as can be separa-

tely removed from the records or papers
of the office; the agents to be permitted
to take the original of the same. The law
is to be of no effect until the Legisla-

ture of Pennsylvania shall repeal such part
of her quarantine laws, as require a longer
time for the admission into the port of Phil-

adelphia, of vessels, and the said laws, which
have been withdrawn within this State, than if such
vessels, &c. had been carried directly on to
the port of Philadelphia.
