"Beauty Boy" has no love for the circus photographer and simply refuses to look pleasant.




This innocent looking tiger is really a bad one, and holds the record for mauling the keepers.

To be in a circus a bear must walk on stilts, roller skate and ride a bicycle.




This is Miss Elizabeth Hanneford. Her mother, grandmother and great-grandmother were circus riders in England.
